Radiation Management Unit staff have reviewed the occupational dose for the subject period. Occupational doses continue to be low. Remedial activities and exposures at the site are being monitored. Dust suppression is of utmost importance on soil handling projects as well as building demolition efforts. We note the use of apportionment for Th-230 for some samples due to delays in installation and use of the new ICPMS.
