

LLS NO. 13-160 AMENDMENT #1  
INTERIM COMMITTEE AMENDMENT  
Committee on Business, Labor and Technology.

LLS No. 13-160 be amended as follows:

1 Amend LLS No. 13-0160.01, page 3, strike lines 8 through 10 and  
2 substitute:

3 "(3) (a) and (5) as follows:

4 **12-58-103. Examining board of plumbers - repeal of article.**  
5 (3) (a) The governor, with power of removal, shall appoint the members  
6 of the board, subject to confirmation by the senate. ~~except that the five~~  
7 ~~members serving on June 30, 1982, shall continue to serve until the~~  
8 ~~expiration of their respective terms of office. The governor shall appoint~~  
9 ~~one additional member to serve until July 1, 1983, and another additional~~  
10 ~~member to serve until July 1, 1986. Thereafter, Members shall be~~ ARE  
11 appointed for four-year terms. Any THE GOVERNOR SHALL FILL ANY  
12 vacancy occurring in the membership of the board ~~shall be filled by the~~  
13 ~~governor~~ by appointment for the unexpired term of such member.

14 (5) This article is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2013~~ SEPTEMBER 1,  
15 2024,".

16 Page 3, line 19, strike "and regulations" and substitute "~~and regulations~~".

17 Page 3, strike lines 20 and 21 and substitute:

18 "governing the plumbing ~~drainage, sewerage, and plumbing ventilation~~  
19 SYSTEMS of all buildings in this state. IN ADOPTING RULES,".

20 Page 6, after line 9, insert:

21 "SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-107, amend  
22 (1) (a) as follows:

23 **12-58-107. License issuance - examination.** (1) (a) The board  
24 shall issue licenses to persons who have by examination and experience  
25 shown themselves competent and qualified to engage in the business,  
26 trade, or calling of a residential plumber, journeyman plumber, or master  
27 plumber. The board shall establish the minimum level of experience  
28 required for an applicant to ~~receive~~ QUALIFY TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION  
29 FOR a residential, journeyman, or master plumber's license. The maximum  
30 experience the board may require for an applicant to qualify to ~~receive~~  
31 TAKE THE EXAMINATION FOR a residential plumber's license is two years

1 or three thousand four hundred hours of practical experience. The  
2 maximum experience the board may require for an applicant to qualify to  
3 ~~receive~~ TAKE THE EXAMINATION FOR a journeyman plumber's license is  
4 four years or six thousand eight hundred hours of practical experience. ~~An~~  
5 ~~applicant for~~ THE MAXIMUM EXPERIENCE THE BOARD MAY REQUIRE FOR  
6 AN APPLICANT TO QUALIFY TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION FOR a master  
7 plumber's license ~~shall furnish evidence that he has~~ IS five years OR EIGHT  
8 THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED HOURS of practical experience.

9 **SECTION 7.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal and reenact,**  
10 **with amendments,** 12-58-107.5 as follows:

11 **12-58-107.5. Credit for experience received outside of**  
12 **Colorado.** FOR ALL APPLICANTS SEEKING WORK EXPERIENCE CREDIT  
13 TOWARD LICENSURE FOR PLUMBING WORK EXPERIENCE RECEIVED OUTSIDE  
14 OF COLORADO, THE BOARD SHALL GIVE CREDIT FOR SUCH WORK  
15 EXPERIENCE IF THE APPLICANT CAN SHOW TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE  
16 BOARD THAT THE PARTICULAR EXPERIENCE IS ADEQUATE TO COMPLY WITH  
17 THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ARTICLE.

18 **SECTION 8.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 12-58-108 as  
19 follows:

20 **12-58-108. License renewal - reinstatement.** (1) All license  
21 AND CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION renewal and renewal fees shall be in  
22 accordance with ~~the provisions of~~ sections 24-34-102 and 24-34-105,  
23 C.R.S.

24 (2) Any license OR CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION that has lapsed  
25 shall be deemed to have expired. Prior to reinstatement, the board is  
26 authorized to require the licensee to demonstrate competency. Licenses  
27 shall be renewed or reinstated pursuant to a schedule established by the  
28 director of the division of professions and occupations within the  
29 department of regulatory agencies and pursuant to section 24-34-102 (8),  
30 C.R.S. The director of the division of professions and occupations within  
31 the department of regulatory agencies may establish renewal fees and  
32 delinquency fees for reinstatement pursuant to section 24-34-105, C.R.S.  
33 If a person fails to renew his or her license pursuant to the schedule  
34 established by the director of the division of professions and occupations,  
35 such license ~~shall expire~~ OR CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION EXPIRES. Any  
36 person whose license has expired ~~shall be~~ IS subject to the penalties  
37 provided in this article or section 24-34-102 (8), C.R.S.

38 **SECTION 9.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-110, **amend**  
39 (1) (p) as follows:

40 **12-58-110. Disciplinary action by board - licenses or**  
41 **registrations denied, suspended, or revoked - cease-and-desist orders.**



1 (1) The board may deny, suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew any license  
2 or registration issued or applied for under the provisions of this article or  
3 place a licensee or a registrant on probation for any of the following  
4 reasons:

5 (p) Selling or fraudulently obtaining or furnishing a license OR  
6 REGISTRATION to practice as a residential, journeyman, or master plumber  
7 OR PLUMBING CONTRACTOR or aiding or abetting in such activity;".

8 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

9 Page 6, strike line 11 and substitute "(1) and (3) (a) introductory portion;  
10 and **add** (8) as follows:".

11 Page 7, after line 4, insert:

12 "(3) (a) All inspection permits issued by the board ~~shall be~~ ARE  
13 valid for a period of twelve months, ~~and the board shall cancel the permit~~  
14 ~~and remove it from its files at the end of the twelve-month period; except~~  
15 in the following circumstances:".

16 Page 7, after line 23, insert:

17 "**SECTION 12.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-58-117, **amend**  
18 (1) as follows:

19 **12-58-117. Apprentices.** (1) Any person may work as a  
20 plumbing apprentice for a ~~licensed plumber~~ but shall not do any plumbing  
21 work for which a license is required pursuant to this article except under  
22 the supervision of a licensed plumber. Supervision requires that the  
23 licensed plumber supervise apprentices at the jobsite. One licensed  
24 journeyman plumber, master plumber, or residential plumber shall not  
25 supervise more than three apprentice plumbers at the same jobsite.".

26 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
