Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Senate Agriculture, Natural Resources, and Energy Committee. The bill continues the state noxious weed advisory committee indefinitely.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (3)
3 (z) (I) as follows:

4 **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees.** (3) The
5 following dates are the dates for which the statutory authorization for the
6 designated advisory committees is scheduled for repeal:

7 (z) July 1, 2013:

8 (I) ~~The state noxious weed advisory committee created in section~~
9 ~~35-5.5-108.7, C.R.S.;~~

10 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 35-5.5-108.7, **repeal**
11 (5) as follows:

12 **35-5.5-108.7. State noxious weed advisory committee.** (5) This
13 section is repealed, effective July 1, 2013. Prior to such repeal, the state
14 noxious weed advisory committee shall be reviewed as provided for in
15 section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.

16 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
18 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
