6 HOURS OF PLANNED TEACHER-PUPIL INSTRUCTION AND TEACHER-PUPIL
7 CONTACT TIME IN A SCHOOL YEAR THAN IS REQUIRED IN SECTION
8 22-32-109 (1) (n) (I). SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS, THE
9 DEPARTMENT SHALL ANNUALLY PAY EXTENDED LEARNING TIME GRANTS
10 FROM THE FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS SECTION. THE STATE
11 BOARD SHALL PROMULGATE RULES PURSUANT TO THE "STATE
12 ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT", ARTICLE 4 OF TITLE 24, C.R.S., AS
13 REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.

14 (2) (a) EACH LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER MAY APPLY FOR AN
15 EXTENDED LEARNING TIME GRANT BY SUBMITTING TO THE DEPARTMENT
16 DOCUMENTATION OF THE NUMBER OF ADDITIONAL HOURS OF PLANNED
17 TEACHER-PUPIL INSTRUCTION AND TEACHER-PUPIL CONTACT TIME THAT
18 THE LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER SCHEDULES AND PROVIDES FOR THE
19 APPLICABLE SCHOOL YEAR. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CALCULATE EACH
20 APPLYING LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER'S EXTENDED LEARNING TIME
21 GRANT AS AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO FIFTY DOLLARS MULTIPLIED BY THE
22 LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER'S AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP FOR THE
23 APPLICABLE BUDGET YEAR, MULTIPLIED BY THE NUMBER OF ADDITIONAL
24 FULL SCHOOL DAY EQUIVALENTS THAT THE LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER
25 SCHEDULES AND PROVIDES, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATION SPECIFIED IN
26 PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2).

27 (b) EACH LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER MAY INITIALLY APPLY BY
28 A DATE SET BY RULE OF THE STATE BOARD FOR AN EXTENDED LEARNING
29 TIME GRANT FOR UP TO TEN ADDITIONAL FULL SCHOOL DAY EQUIVALENTS.
30 IF, AFTER THAT DATE, THERE ARE UNENCUMBERED MONEYS REMAINING IN
31 THE EXTENDED LEARNING TIME GRANT FUND, A LOCAL EDUCATION
32 PROVIDER THAT SCHEDULES MORE THAN TEN ADDITIONAL FULL SCHOOL
33 DAY EQUIVALENTS MAY APPLY FOR ADDITIONAL MONEYS FROM THE FUND,
34 UP TO THE ACTUAL NUMBER OF ADDITIONAL FULL SCHOOL DAY
35 EQUIVALENTS SCHEDULED.

36 (c) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CALCULATE THE AMOUNT OF EACH
37 LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER'S EXTENDED LEARNING TIME GRANT BASED
38 ON THE SCHEDULED NUMBER OF ADDITIONAL HOURS OF PLANNED
39 TEACHER-PUPIL INSTRUCTION AND TEACHER-PUPIL CONTACT TIME. BY A
40 DATE SET BY RULE OF THE STATE BOARD, EACH LOCAL EDUCATION
41 PROVIDER SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT DOCUMENTATION OF THE

1 ACTUAL NUMBER OF HOURS OF PLANNED TEACHER-PUPIL INSTRUCTION
2 AND TEACHER-PUPIL CONTACT TIME THAT THE LOCAL EDUCATION
3 PROVIDER PROVIDED DURING THE APPLICABLE SCHOOL YEAR, AND THE
4 DEPARTMENT SHALL ADJUST THE GRANT AMOUNT ACCORDINGLY.

5 (3) (a) THERE IS CREATED IN THE STATE TREASURY THE EXTENDED
6 LEARNING TIME GRANT FUND, REFERRED TO IN THIS SUBSECTION (3) AS
7 THE "FUND". THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL ANNUALLY APPROPRIATE TO
8 THE FUND AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS MULTIPLIED BY
9 THE STATEWIDE AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP FOR THE APPLICABLE
10 BUDGET YEAR. THE MONEYS IN THE FUND ARE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL
11 APPROPRIATION BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR
12 DISTRIBUTION TO LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDERS AS PROVIDED IN THIS
13 SECTION.

14 (b) THE STATE TREASURER MAY INVEST ANY MONEYS IN THE FUND
15 NOT EXPENDED FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
16 THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ALL INTEREST AND INCOME DERIVED
17 FROM THE INVESTMENT AND DEPOSIT OF MONEYS IN THE FUND TO THE
18 FUND. ANY UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED MONEYS REMAINING IN
19 THE FUND AT THE END OF A FISCAL YEAR MUST REMAIN IN THE FUND AND
20 SHALL NOT BE CREDITED OR TRANSFERRED TO THE GENERAL FUND OR
21 ANOTHER FUND.

22 (4) IN A BUDGET YEAR IN WHICH THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DOES
23 NOT APPROPRIATE A SUFFICIENT AMOUNT TO FULLY FUND THE
24 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REDUCE EACH
25 APPLYING LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER'S EXTENDED LEARNING TIME
26 GRANT BY THE SAME PERCENTAGE THAT THE DEFICIT BEARS TO THE
27 AMOUNT REQUIRED TO FULLY FUND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
28 SECTION."
