HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Education.SB13-213 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 15, after line 20, insert:

2 "(3) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT THE MONEYS
3 APPROPRIATED FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES WILL BENEFIT THE
4 EDUCATION OF STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN THROUGH TWELFTH GRADE
5 AND PARTICIPANTS IN PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS BY IMPLEMENTING
6 PROGRAMMATIC ENHANCEMENTS:

7 (a) DISTRIBUTING TEACHER AND LEADERSHIP INVESTMENTS
8 MONEYS PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-54.5-301 TO ASSIST DISTRICTS AND
9 INSTITUTE CHARTER SCHOOLS IN IMPLEMENTING EDUCATION REFORM
10 MEASURES;

11 (b) INCREASING THE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR AT-RISK PUPILS;

12 (c) INCREASING THE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR ENGLISH
13 LANGUAGE LEARNERS;

14 (d) FUNDING ALL KINDERGARTEN PUPILS AS FULL-TIME PUPILS;

15 (e) FUNDING ALL ELIGIBLE THREE-, FOUR-, AND FIVE-YEAR-OLD
16 PUPILS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COLORADO PRESCHOOL PROGRAM
17 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 28 OF THIS TITLE;

18 (f) FUNDING ALL SECONDARY STUDENTS AS FULL-TIME PUPILS;

19 (g) INCREASING THE FUNDING FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES AS
20 PROVIDED IN SECTION 22-20-114;

21 (h) INCREASING THE FUNDING FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN
22 MULTI-DISTRICT ON-LINE SCHOOLS AND STUDENTS WHO PARTICIPATE IN
23 THE ASCENT PROGRAM;

24 (i) INCREASING THE FUNDING FOR GIFTED AND TALENTED
25 STUDENTS;

26 (j) DISTRIBUTING PER PUPIL SUPPLEMENTAL PAYMENTS PURSUANT
27 TO SECTION 22-54.5-303 TO ENSURE THAT ALL DISTRICTS RECEIVE A
28 MINIMUM LEVEL OF FUNDING;

29 (k) FUNDING THE EDUCATION INNOVATION GRANT PROGRAM
30 CREATED IN SECTION 22-54.5-312;

31 (l) INCREASING THE SIZE FACTOR FOR DISTRICTS WITH FEWER THAN
32 FOUR THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED STUDENTS;

33 (m) DISTRIBUTING HOLD-HARMLESS FUNDING TO DISTRICTS TO
34 HELP ENSURE THEY RECEIVE FULL TOTAL PROGRAM FUNDING;

35 (n) MATCHING A PORTION OF THE VOTER-APPROVED INCREASES IN
36 THE PROPERTY TAX MILL LEVY FOR DISTRICTS WITH LOW ASSESSED
37 VALUATION;

38 (o) INCREASING THE FUNDING FOR CHARTER SCHOOL FACILITIES;



- 1 (p) FUNDING A MILL LEVY EQUALIZATION FACTOR FOR INSTITUTE
2 CHARTER SCHOOLS TO RAISE THE FUNDING FOR INSTITUTE CHARTER
3 SCHOOLS TO A LEVEL MORE COMPARABLE TO DISTRICTS;
4 (q) FUNDING A STATEWIDE PROGRAM TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL
5 CAREER OPPORTUNITIES FOR HIGHLY EFFECTIVE EDUCATORS;
6 (r) FUNDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A DATA SYSTEM THAT WILL
7 SUPPORT THE DATA COLLECTION FOR AND CALCULATION OF AVERAGE
8 DAILY MEMBERSHIP; AND
9 (s) FUNDING THE ELECTION COSTS INCURRED BY DISTRICTS THAT
10 SEEK VOTER APPROVAL FOR AN INCREASE IN THE TOTAL PROGRAM MILL
11 LEVY.".
