HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Public Health Care & Human Services.HB13-1309 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 3, strike "**repeal** (18) (b) (III); and".
- 2 Page 2, strike line 4 and substitute "and **repeal** (18) (b) (III)".
- 3 Page 3, strike line 18 and substitute:
- 4 **"SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-16-104, **repeal**
- 5 **as amended by House Bill 13-1266** (18) (b) (III) (A), (18) (b) (III) (C),
- 6 and (18) (b) (III) (D) as follows:
- 7 (18) **Preventive health care services.** (b) The coverage required
- 8 by this subsection (18) must include preventive health care services for
- 9 the following, in accordance with the A or B recommendations of the task
- 10 force for the particular preventive health care service:
- 11 ~~(III) (A) One breast cancer screening with mammography per~~
- 12 ~~year, covering the actual charge for the screening with mammography.~~
- 13 ~~(C) Benefits for preventive mammography screenings are~~
- 14 ~~determined on a calendar year or a contract year basis, which fact must be~~
- 15 ~~specified in the policy or contract. The preventive and diagnostic~~
- 16 ~~coverages provided pursuant to this subparagraph (III) do not diminish or~~
- 17 ~~limit diagnostic benefits otherwise allowable under a policy or contract.~~
- 18 ~~If the covered person receives more than one in a given calendar year or~~
- 19 ~~contract year, the other benefit provisions in the policy or contract apply~~

- 21 ~~(D) Notwithstanding the A or B recommendations of the task~~
- 22 ~~force, a policy or contract subject to this subsection (18) must cover an~~

- 24 ~~possessing at least one risk factor, including a family history of breast~~
- 25 ~~cancer, being forty years of age or older, or a genetic predisposition to~~

- 27 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-16-104, **add**
- 28 (18.5) as follows:
- 29 **10-16-104. Mandatory coverage provisions - definitions.**
- 30 (18.5) **Breast imaging.** (a) ALL INDIVIDUAL AND ALL GROUP".
- 31 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 32 Page 3, line 26, strike "THE TOTAL COST OF" and substitute "PREVENTIVE
- 33 MAMMOGRAPHY AND DIAGNOSTIC".



- 1 Page 4, line 1, after "(b)" insert "(I)".
- 2 Page 4, line 2, after "FOR" insert "PREVENTIVE MAMMOGRAPHY AND
3 DIAGNOSTIC".
- 4 Page 4, strike lines 3 through 9 and substitute "EXAMINATION, FOR ALL
5 INDIVIDUALS:
6 (A) POSSESSING AT LEAST ONE RISK FACTOR FOR BREAST CANCER,
7 INCLUDING A FAMILY HISTORY OF BREAST CANCER;
8 (B) FORTY YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER;
9 (C) PRESENTING WITH SYMPTOMS; OR
10 (D) WITH AN INCREASED LIFETIME RISK OF BREAST CANCER
11 DETERMINED BY A RISK FACTOR MODEL SUCH AS TYRER-CUZICK,
12 BRCAPRO, OR GAIL.
13 (II) THE COVERAGE FOR PREVENTIVE MAMMOGRAPHY IS NOT
14 SUBJECT TO POLICY DEDUCTIBLES, COPAYMENTS, OR COINSURANCE.
15 (III) THE COVERAGE FOR BREAST IMAGING IS NOT SUBJECT TO
16 COST-SHARING. FOR".
- 17 Page 4, line 10. strike ""BREAST" and substitute ""DIAGNOSTIC BREAST".
- 18 Page 4, line 11, before "NECESSARY" insert "MEDICALLY".
- 19 page 4, strike lines 13 and 14 and substitute "DETECTION OF BREAST
20 CANCER.".
- 21 Page 7, strike lines 20 and 21 and substitute:
- 22 **"SECTION 8. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
23 **applicability.** (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, this act
24 takes effect January 1, 2015.
25 (2) Section 2 of this act takes effect only if House Bill 13-1266
26 becomes law.
27 (3) Sections 1 and 5 of this act takes effect only if House Bill
28 13-1266 does not become law.
29 (4) If a".
- 30 Page 8, line 2, strike "(2)" and substitute "(5)".

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
