

1.6 – Community Input

To the extent that a locality issues local licenses for adult-use marijuana establishments, a locality may schedule a public hearing upon the application. If the locality schedules a hearing for a local license application, it shall post and publish public notice thereof not less than ten days prior to the hearing. The locality shall give public notice by posting a sign in a conspicuous place on the license applicant's premises for which a local license application has been made and by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the applicant's premises are located or on the website of the locality.

Should a locality choose not to issue local licenses, the locality may give public notice of the state application by posting a sign in a conspicuous place on the state license applicant's premises for which license application has been made and by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the applicant's premises are located or on the website of the locality.
