SUBJECT: Fiscal Assessment of Proposed Amendment **HB1139_L.002**.

This memorandum is an assessment of the fiscal impact of the attached proposed amendment L.002 to **HB13-1139**. This fiscal assessment is for the impact of the bill with inclusion of this amendment only. Any other added amendment could influence the fiscal impact.

Summary of Proposed Amendment

Amendment L.002 to HB13-1139 corrects a drafting error and eliminates the repeal of the Radiation Advisory Committee (Section 25-11-105, C.R.S.).

Fiscal Impact of Amendment

Eliminating the repeal of the Radiation Advisory Committee increases the fiscal impact of the bill by \$14,246 and 0.2 FTE, the current cost of operating the committee. Adoption of this part of the amendment means that the operation of the Radiation Advisory Committee will continue under current law.

Bill's Revised Fiscal Impact with Amendment

With Amendment L.002 to HB13-1139, the bill is assessed as having **no fiscal impact**. Entities repealed by the bill have been deemed obsolete because of a significant period of inactivity, lack of appointees, fulfillment of duties, or prior transfer of functions to other entities.
