




- The Regional Care Coordination Organizations (RCCOs) reflect Colorado's approach to implementing coordinated care for the Medicaid program to reduce costs and improve health outcomes. Colorado is leading the country in applying an accountable care model for Medicaid, and while it will take time to realize its full cost-saving potential, the RCCO program is producing promising initial results
- Colorado is divided into seven RCCO regions, where local leaders come together to create health care delivery systems that serve the needs of local communities. The result is seven community-based models that look different, but share the fundamental principle of coordinating care within patient-centered medical homes.
- All RCCOs integrate physical, behavioral, and social needs of enrollees. RCCOs are transforming the way care is delivered into medical neighborhoods where care is coordinated among providers, reducing fragmentation and duplication. This results not only in better health outcomes, but lower costs.
- Payment reform is directly linked to transforming health care. HB12-1282 is a step toward reforming payments strategies for each region and provides an opportunity to test innovative payment models.
