SB13-137 be amended as follows:

1 Amend proposed committee amendment (SB137_L.002), page 2, after
2 line 25 insert:

3 "(3) IN ADDITION TO THE INFORMATION PROVIDED PURSUANT TO
4 SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION, A POTENTIAL CONTRACTOR RESPONDING
5 TO THE REQUEST FOR INFORMATION SHALL INCLUDE INFORMATION
6 CONCERNING:

7 (a) THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE POTENTIAL CONTRACTOR WILL
8 SEEK CLINICAL AND TECHNICAL EXPERTISE FROM COLORADO PROVIDERS
9 CONCERNING THE DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MEDICAID FRAUD
10 DETECTION SYSTEM DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION AND THE METHOD OR
11 METHODS FOR SEEKING THAT EXPERTISE; AND

12 (b) THE POTENTIAL CONTRACTOR'S ABILITY TO CREATE AN
13 EDUCATION AND OUTREACH PROGRAM THAT IS WIDELY AVAILABLE AND
14 EASILY ACCESSIBLE TO COLORADO PROVIDERS FOR PURPOSES OF
15 EDUCATING PROVIDERS ON ISSUES RELATING TO COVERAGE AND CODING."

16 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.

17 Page 2, line 26, strike "(3)" and substitute "(4) (a)".

18 Page 2, line 30, strike "(a)" and substitute "(I)".

19 Page 2, line 32, strike "(b)" and substitute "(II)".

20 Page 2, line 35, strike "(c)" and substitute "(III)".

21 Page 2, after line 36 insert:

22 "(b) PRIOR TO AWARDING ANY CONTRACT PURSUANT TO THIS
23 SECTION, THE STATE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AN APPEAL PROCESS
24 FOR PROVIDERS THAT MINIMIZES THE ADMINISTRATIVE BURDEN PLACED
25 ON PROVIDERS, LIMITS THE NUMBER OF MEDICAL RECORDS REQUESTS, AND
26 PROVIDES ADEQUATE TIME FOR PROVIDERS TO RESPOND TO INQUIRIES."
