Dear Rep. Labuda

I wanted to write in support of your bill requiring labeling of genetically modified products. I have been a practicing physician in Colorado for 27 years. I have a special interest in irritable bowel syndrome (IBS). During this time I have worked closely with many patients who are gluten sensitive. The problem has been compounded in recent years by the introduction of GMO produced wheat, which has almost twice the gluten content of non-genetically modified wheat. Many of my patients who travel to Europe seem to tolerate the bread and pasta there, which is not genetically modified, more easily than they do with the grains available in the United States. In a separate e-mail I will send you a paper that I recently wrote on this topic. It will be going out in our newsletter.

I think that this is a very important topic that will become more of an issue as our understanding of the ramifications of introducing GMO produced grains into the food chain.
