Dedicated on the 100th anniversary of the 1915 Armenian Genocide — the tragedy that instigated the definition of the crime of genocide and prompted Coloradans to humanitarian outreach — this monument honors the victims of all crimes against humanity. Crafted in Armenia, this cultural monument is a replica of a medieval khachkar from a vanished cemetery. In 2010 the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization recognized the value and vulnerability of this art form by declaring it part of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

1 Building Advisory Committee to establish criteria and a procedure for the

4 WHEREAS, The State Capitol Building Advisory Committee's  
5 evaluation criteria for a memorial is based partly upon the association the  
6 proposed memorial has with a significant event in the state's history, the  
7 connection of the memorial with persons significant in the heritage of the  
8 state, and its appropriateness to the designated area of the State Capitol;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, The procedure stipulates that, if the Capital  
11 Development Committee and the Governor concur with the State Capitol  
12 Building Advisory Committee's recommendations regarding the  
13 placement of memorials on the State Capitol grounds, the Capital  
14 Development Committee may make its recommendation for acceptance  
15 of the donated art to the General Assembly in the form of a joint  
16 resolution introduced during an annual legislative session; and

17 WHEREAS, The State Capitol Building Advisory Committee, the  
18 Capital Development Committee, and the Governor have approved a plan
