*SUPPORT ENABLING LEGISLATION FOR ELECTRONIC PROCESSING OF MOTOR VEHICLE LIENS,  
REGISTRATION AND TITLING*

It will benefit consumers, lenders, new and used motor vehicle dealers, Department of Motor Vehicles and County Clerks by making liens, registration and titles secure, more accurate and accessible online

- An electronic title and lien system would allow:
  - Elimination of paper and storage costs for lenders
  - Lenders to instantly release liens
  - Verification, correction or tracking of liens and titles
  - Updating registration, ownership and viewing of lien history
  - Titles and liens to be transferred electronically to other states if consumers move
- Authorizes Division of Motor Vehicle to explore electronic registration and temporary tags
- Creates a motor vehicle dealer inquiry system to check the status of a title and/or lien
- Consumers wouldn't have to keep track of paper titles anymore unless requested
- Reduces consumer visits to County Clerk offices for lien, registration & title questions
- State, counties, law enforcement and private sector can expect fewer fraud cases resulting from Colorado implementing this system

Many states have already transitioned to an electronic system with great success

Stakeholders will be part of implementing system through department rulemaking process
