My name is [REDACTED] a resident of Douglas County. I write this request to cancel my voting registration for the following reasons:

On 09/13/2001, I went to DMV location in highlands Ranch (located at county line Blvd) to issue a new ID after moving from California. The employee received my request and issued a new ID, and then you did send me a card for voting. As an innocent immigrant and without enough knowledge, I did vote twice because I thought that this is my obligation and duty and if I didn't vote, my situation as an immigrant will be jeopardized. Unfortunately this was done few years before now. I am a permanent resident for more and in the process of applying for my citizenship. I did attend a class about citizenship where I figured out that all immigrants who have permanent residency should not vote. I checked your web site where I was shocked found me registered with ID voter.

I didn't apply for registration. No employee at the DMV asked me any question about that. How do you register any person who is not a citizen? What is the system you follow before registration, to be sure that every registered is a citizen??. I honestly I don't see any in my case and others.

I have to cancel my registration for voting to secure my citizenship. Also I will send copies of this request to many authorities in Colorado and in the government to protect my rights.

It is unacceptable from some employees to put the innocent immigrants in such horrible and threatening situations.

As a permanent resident I am asking you to do investigations about these mistakes that may have serious damages to the future of innocent immigrants and their families. Let the employees clarify every document to any person before signing.

I hope this may help you for a better service in the future


Dear Ms. Johnson:

I am returning the enclosed Voter Registration Information card, and request that my name be removed from the rolls, because I am a Canadian citizen, and not eligible to vote in an election in the United States.

I was approached by a voter registration volunteer at a mall recently, and she informed me that as a legal resident of Colorado, having lived here for many years, I was eligible to vote in local elections but not national ones. I was sure she was wrong, but at her insistence, I filled out a brief application, which she described as merely a request that would answer my doubts one way or the other. I did check the box stating I was not a citizen, and expected to hear further (that I was not eligible), but instead received the enclosed card.

I regret any inconvenience to you or your staff. I do wish that volunteers would be properly trained and hope that this person did not obtain more signed requests due to this misinformation on her part.

I do solemnly affirm that I am a citizen of the United States, that I have attained the age of eighteen years, and that I have resided in the State of Colorado and in my present precinct at least thirty days before the election, or at my current residence address since the date moved as shown above. I further affirm that the address indicated in this affidavit is my sole legal residence and that I claim no other place as my legal residence. I affirm that:

If I applied for an Absentee Ballot I have not and will not cast the Absentee Ballot that I requested.  
I further affirm under penalty of law that I have not and will not cast any vote in this election except by the enclosed ballot, that I will not vote in any other precinct, county or state, and that my ballot is enclosed in accordance with the provisions of the "Uniform Election Code of 1992", Articles 1 to 13 of Title 1, Colorado Revised Statutes.

### WARNING:

It is a CRIME to make false affirmations as to your qualifications to vote punishable under the elections and criminal codes of the State of Colorado. Any person who votes by knowingly giving false information regarding the elector's place of present residence commits a class 6 felony punishable by a fine of up to \$100,000 and/or up to 18 months imprisonment. Falsely personating an elector is punishable by a fine up to \$5,000 and/or up to 18 months imprisonment. Under 1-13-104 C.R.S., willfully or falsely taking an oath or affirmation or suborning another person to falsely swear or affirm falsely, commits perjury in the 2nd degree, punishable by a fine up to \$5,000 and/or up to 18 months imprisonment.

If you are currently a convicted felon serving a sentence of detention or confinement or on parole, your provisional ballot will not count.

RE: Registered and Withdrawal of Voter Registration History

When I first moved to Colorado from Calgary, Alberta Canada and being employed by a Colorado based company [REDACTED] on a NAFTA TN Work Permit I went to get a Colorado Drivers License.

When I was applying for this license the DMV clerk asked me if I wanted to register to vote. I indicated to her that I was not a US citizen and thought that 1. I would not be legible to vote and 2. I did not think it was right that I should be able to vote being a non-US citizen. I do recall that we had quite the discussion on this subject.

I do not recall the exact details but I do think that this clerk did register me to vote even after what I thought was a logical argument on my part as to why I should not be registered. I only suspected this registration had occurred after a period of time when I started getting election ballots in the mail.

Just to be clear on this – I have never voted in any election process while living in the USA. I knew that this would be fundamentally wrong if not actually legally wrong.


On June 05, 2012 I received another official Election Bailot (enclosed unopened) in the Mail which prompted me to call the Douglas County Clerk & Recorder's Office. I confirmed that I was indeed registered and inquired as to the process of withdrawing my registration.

I was directed to the State of Colorado elections web site by a clerk in the Douglas County Clerk's office which is where I have filled out the Withdrawal Form (attached).

I do think that the whole process has a problem or had a problem at the time I applied for my License and that is the DMV clerk did not fully understand eligibility for voting.

If I do decide to apply for a permanent USA residence status in the future then I would anticipate applying to be a legal eligible voter at that time.




