Description: The Colorado Wildlife Habitat Stamp Committee consists of 11 members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate as follows:

- 4 sportspersons who represent the four quadrants of the state;
- 2 representatives of national or regionally recognized conservation organizations whose missions are focused on nongame wildlife and whose membership is composed primarily of nongame wildlife users;
- 2 landowners actively engaged in agriculture;
- 1 citizen at large; and
- 2 Division of Wildlife representatives as ex officio members, at least one of whom shall be a wildlife biologist.

Terms are for four years each and members shall be limited to two consecutive four-year terms. The committee is repealed December 31, 2013, but prior to its repeal, the committee shall receive a sunset review as provided for in section 2-3-1203.


