

9.1 – Cultivation and Handling Standards

To help ensure the safety and consistency of plant products sold to Colorado consumers, the Task Force recommends that:

- (1) **The Governor shall designate** A an appropriate governmental agency, ~~either the Colorado Department of Agriculture, the Colorado Department of Revenue, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, or a combination of these agencies, shall be authorized by statute~~ to create a list of substances banned for use in the cultivation or processing of marijuana based upon that in current Rule 14.100(E) for medical marijuana. **The designated agency shall be authorized to work in consultation with any other appropriate agency it deems necessary;**
- (2) Labeling of all products shall include a list of all pesticides, herbicides, fungicides, and solvents that were used in its cultivation or processing. It should be noted that the regulation should not address whether the products used are appropriate or legal under applicable agricultural laws or regulations.
