**Summary of Legislation**

This bill establishes that the boundaries of a fire protection district (FPD) are not modified when a town or city annexes part of the FPD's territory. An FPD may take action to adjust its boundaries at any time, as allowed by current law. In addition, the bill requires that the annexation impact report prepared by a city or town identify the effects of annexation in the FPD.

**State Expenditures**

The Division of Local Government (DLG) in the Department of Local Affairs will modify materials and training related to municipal annexations. Such updates are routine and completed on a regular schedule by the DLG. The DLG workload increase under the bill is negligible and will not require additional appropriations.

**Local Government Impact**

Additional analysis in an annexation impact report will result in a minimal increase in costs for cities and towns. Municipal annexations commonly involve territory served by a FPD.
