Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$8,035 General Fund and 0.1 FTE to the Department of Education for FY 2013-14.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2013-14 based on the March 2013 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package allocates all but approximately \$9.0 million of General Fund revenues projected to be available. Pursuant to S.B. 13-236, this \$9.0 million General Fund will be transferred to the Colorado Water Conservation Board

(CWCB) Construction Fund. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$8,035 for FY 2013-14 and thus will reduce the transfer to the CWCB Construction Fund by that amount.
