After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB13-1167 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 9 through 11 and substitute "OF
2 STATE UPON INITIAL REGISTRATION OF A BUSINESS AND WHEN UPDATING
3 A BUSINESS REGISTRATION. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL REQUEST
4 THAT EACH REPORTING ENTITY, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION
5 7-90-102 (58), C.R.S., TO WHICH THE FILING RELATES, SUBMIT THE
6 FOLLOWING INFORMATION ABOUT THE REPORTING ENTITY: GENDER; RACE,
7 INCLUDING WHETHER THE PERSON IS LATINO, AFRICAN AMERICAN, ASIAN,
8 ANGLO, NATIVE AMERICAN, OR OTHER; VETERAN STATUS; WHETHER THE
9 REPORTING ENTITY IS A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY; AND THE NATIONAL
10 AMERICAN INDUSTRY CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM CODE OR ITS SUCCESSOR
11 CODE OF THE REPORTING ENTITY'S BUSINESS, IF APPLICABLE."

12 Page 2, line 12, strike "DISABILITY."

13 Page 2, line 14, strike "PUBLIC." and substitute "PUBLIC ON THE
14 SECRETARY OF STATE'S WEB SITE IN A SEARCHABLE MANNER BY THE
15 INFORMATION SUBMITTED."

16 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 15 through 17 and substitute:

17 **"SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
18 takes effect January 1, 2014, except that, if a referendum petition is filed
19 pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this
20 act or an item, section, or part of this act within the ninety-day period

1 after final adjournment of the general assembly, then the act, item,
2 section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the
3 general election to be held in November 2014 and, in such case, will take
4 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the
5 governor."

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
