After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB14-1066 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 4, after line 25 insert:
2 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-114, **repeal** (4)
3 (b); and **repeal and reenact, with amendments**, (2) as follows:
4 **42-2-114. License issued - fees - repeal - rules.** (2) (a) A FEE IS
5 REQUIRED FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE TO A PERSON
6 TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SET THE
7 FEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 42-2-114.5. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN
8 SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS SECTION, THE LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE
9 APPLICANT'S BIRTHDAY IN THE FIFTH YEAR AFTER ISSUANCE OF THE
10 LICENSE.
11 (b) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSFER THE FEE TO THE STATE
12 TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE FEE TO THE LICENSING SERVICES
13 CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION 42-2-114.5.
14 (c) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2):
15 (I) IF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE IS ISSUED BY THE OFFICE OF A COUNTY
16 CLERK AND RECORDER IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF AT LEAST ONE
17 HUNDRED THOUSAND INDIVIDUALS, THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER
18 SHALL RETAIN THE SUM OF EIGHT DOLLARS AND FORWARD THE
19 REMAINDER TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSMISSION TO THE STATE
20 TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE REMAINDER OF THE FEE TO THE
21 LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND.
22 (II) IF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE IS ISSUED BY AN OFFICE OF A COUNTY
23 CLERK AND RECORDER IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF FEWER THAN
24 ONE HUNDRED THOUSANDS INDIVIDUALS, THE COUNTY CLERK AND
25 RECORDER SHALL RETAIN THE SUM OF THIRTEEN DOLLARS AND SIXTY

1 CENTS AND FORWARD THE REMAINDER TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR
2 TRANSMISSION TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE
3 REMAINDER OF THE FEE TO THE LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND.

4 (d) IN ADDITION TO THE FEE ESTABLISHED IN PARAGRAPH (a) OF
5 THIS SUBSECTION (2), A SURCHARGE OF TWO DOLLARS IS ADDED FOR
6 ISSUANCE OF A DRIVER'S OR MINOR DRIVER'S LICENSE WITH A
7 MOTORCYCLE ENDORSEMENT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSFER THE
8 SURCHARGE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT IT TO THE
9 MOTORCYCLE OPERATOR SAFETY TRAINING FUND, CREATED IN SECTION
10 43-5-504, C.R.S.

11 (e) IN ADDITION TO THE FEE ESTABLISHED IN PARAGRAPH (a) OF
12 THIS SUBSECTION (2), A SURCHARGE IS ADDED FOR ISSUANCE OF A
13 DRIVER'S OR MINOR DRIVER'S LICENSE WHEN AN APPLICANT RETAKES
14 EITHER THE EXAMINATION OF KNOWLEDGE OF THE TRAFFIC LAWS OF THIS
15 STATE OR THE DEMONSTRATION OF THE APPLICANT'S ABILITY TO EXERCISE
16 ORDINARY AND REASONABLE CARE AND CONTROL IN THE OPERATION OF
17 A MOTOR VEHICLE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SET THE SURCHARGE BY RULE
18 IN AN AMOUNT TO OFFSET THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COST OF GIVING THE
19 EXAMINATION OR DEMONSTRATION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSFER
20 THE SURCHARGE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT IT TO THE
21 LICENSING SERVICES CASH FUND, CREATED IN SECTION 42-2-114.5.

22 (4) (b) ~~(F) Prior to July 1, 2006, a surcharge of one dollar shall be~~
23 ~~added for issuance of a minor driver's license for which a motorcycle~~
24 ~~endorsement is requested which shall be credited to the motorcycle~~
25 ~~operator safety training fund created in section 43-5-504, C.R.S.~~

26 ~~(H) On and after July 1, 2006, a surcharge of two dollars shall be~~
27 ~~added for issuance of a minor driver's license for which a motorcycle~~
28 ~~endorsement is requested which shall be credited to the motorcycle~~
29 ~~operator safety training fund created in section 43-5-504, C.R.S."~~

30 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

31 Page 6, strike lines 11 through 22 and substitute:

32 **"SECTION 5. Effective date - applicability.** (1) (a) Except as
33 otherwise provided in this section, this act takes effect July 1, 2014.

34 (b) Section 1 of this act takes effect only if Senate Bill 14-194
35 does not become law.

36 (c) Section 2 of this act takes effect only if Senate Bill 14-194
37 becomes law.

38 (2) This act applies to driver's licenses issued on or after the
39 applicable effective date of this act.

1 **SECTION 6. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
2 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
3 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."

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
