**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$150,000 total funds, including \$75,000 General Fund and \$75,000 federal funds, to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing for FY 2014-15 to conduct the study required by the bill.

**Points to Consider**

*General Fund Impact*

The general appropriations bill for FY 2014-15 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$75,000 for FY 2014-15, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other existing programs.
