After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB14-1055 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike everything below the enacting clause
2 and substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-209, **amend**
4 (2) as follows:

5 **42-3-209. Legislative license plates.** (2) (a) (I) Upon application
6 of an owner of either a passenger car or a truck not over sixteen thousand
7 pounds empty weight showing that ~~such~~ THE owner is a member of the
8 general assembly of the state of Colorado, the department may SPECIALLY
9 REGISTER THE VEHICLE AND assign to ~~such~~ THE owner ~~in lieu of the~~
10 ~~distinct registration number specified in section 42-3-113 (1) (a);~~
11 registration plates bearing:

12 (A) ~~A number together with appropriate words or letters~~
13 ~~indicating that such owner is a member of the general assembly of the~~
14 ~~state of Colorado~~ THE LETTER "H" IF THE MEMBER IS A REPRESENTATIVE
15 OR THE LETTER "S" IF THE MEMBER IS A SENATOR; and

16 (B) ~~a separate number series, based on senatorial and~~
17 ~~representative districts, to further identify such license plates~~ THE
18 NUMBER OF THE SENATORIAL OR REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT OF THE
19 MEMBER.

20 (II) THE LETTER AND NUMBER COMBINATION IN
21 SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS SECTION (a)
22 IS THE OWNER'S REGISTRATION NUMBER.

23 (b) A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ELIGIBLE FOR

1 SPECIAL REGISTRATION AND LICENSE PLATES ISSUED UNDER THIS
2 SUBSECTION (2) FOR THE TERM THAT THE MEMBER IS ELECTED TO SERVE
3 IN OFFICE; EXCEPT THAT THE REGISTRATION AND PLATES EXPIRE WHEN THE
4 PERSON LEAVES OFFICE FOR ANY REASON.

5 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
6 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
7 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
8 general assembly (August 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7,
9 2014); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
10 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
11 or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
12 will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
13 to be held in November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the
14 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

15 (2) This act applies to vehicles registered or license plates issued
16 on or after January 1, 2015."
