The bill provides for the continuation of certain state agency rules and regulations and the expiration of others. The bill reflects recommendations made by the Committee on Legal Services following a review of state agency rules and regulations that were adopted or amended between November 1, 2012, and November 1, 2013.

Rules are scheduled for repeal or expiration in the rule review bill when the Committee on Legal Services finds that the rule lacks statutory authority or conflicts with state law. Under the bill, expiring rules are repealed on May 15, 2014.

**Assessment**

The bill continues rules that were determined to comply with state law and allows others to expire. These actions will not affect state or local government revenue or expenditures, and, therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Effective Date**

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
