Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB14-1124 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 4, after line 1, insert:

2 **"SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments to 2014 long bill.**

3 (1) For the implementation of this act, the general fund appropriation
4 made in the annual general appropriation act to the controlled
5 maintenance trust fund created in section 24-75-302.5 (2) (a), Colorado
6 Revised Statutes, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, is decreased
7 by \$783,000.

8 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
9 appropriated, out of any moneys in the general fund, not otherwise
10 appropriated, to the department of higher education, for the fiscal year
11 beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$783,000 to be allocated to the college
12 opportunity fund program for stipends for students attending state
13 institutions.

14 (3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
15 appropriated to the department of higher education, for the fiscal year
16 beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$783,000. Said sum is from
17 reappropriated funds that are appropriated to the college opportunity fund
18 program in subsection (2) of this section and shall be allocated to the
19 governing boards as follows:

20 (a) \$4,500 for the trustees of Metropolitan state university of
21 Denver;

22 (b) \$4,500 for the trustees of Western state Colorado university;

23 (c) \$39,375 for the board of governors of the Colorado state

1 university system;
2 (d) \$303,750 for the regents of the university of Colorado;
3 (e) \$30,375 for the Colorado school of Mines; and
4 (f) \$400,500 for the state board for community colleges and
5 occupational education state system community colleges.
6 (4) The general assembly anticipates that, for the fiscal year
7 beginning July 1, 2014, student tuition reflected in the annual general
8 appropriation act in the department of higher education will be reduced
9 by the sum of \$5,346,257 cash funds for the implementation of this act.
10 This amount is subject to the (I) notation as defined in the annual general
11 appropriations act. Although these funds are not appropriated in this act,
12 they are noted for the purpose of indicating the assumptions used relative
13 to these funds. Said reduction shall be allocated to the governing boards
14 as follows:

15	Trustees of Metropolitan state university of Denver	(\$23,362)
16	Trustees of Western state Colorado university	(19,738)
17	Board of governors of the Colorado state university	
18	system	(276,360)
19	Regents of the university of Colorado	(2,955,960)
20	Colorado school of Mines	(202,905)
21	State board for community colleges and occupational	
22	education state system community colleges	(1,867,932)".
