Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$5,202 cash funds from the Liquor Enforcement Division and State Licensing Authority Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue, Liquor and Tobacco Enforcement Division for FY 2014-15 to implement the bill and reappropriates \$4,120 of those moneys to the Governor's Office of Information Technology to perform programming work for the Department of Revenue.
