**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes a provision that appropriates \$97,850 cash funds from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account of the Highway Users Tax Fund to the Department of Revenue, Information Technology Division for FY 2014-15 to reprogram the Department's computer systems to implement the bill and reappropriates those moneys to the Governor's Office of Information Technology to perform the programming work for the Department of Revenue.
