HB14-1065 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 2, strike "40-10.1-101," and substitute
- 2 "42-7-103,".

- 3 Page 2, line 3, strike "(22)" and substitute "(16)".

- 4 Page 2, line 4, strike "**40-10.1-101.**" and substitute "**42-7-103.**".

- 5 Page 2, line 6, strike "(22)" and substitute "(16)".

- 6 Page 2, line 7, strike "UNDERSTANDING" and substitute "UNDERSTANDING,
- 7 WHETHER WRITTEN OR ORAL, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED,".

- 8 Page 2, line 26, strike "40-10.1-107.5" and substitute "42-7-505.5".

- 9 Page 3, line 2, strike "**40-10.1-107.5.**" and substitute "**42-7-505.5.**" and
- 10 strike "**void.**" and substitute "**void - choice of law for transportation**
- 11 **contracts. (1)**".

- 12 Page 3, strike lines 11 through 20 and substitute:

- 13 "(2) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY CONTRACTUAL PROVISION TO THE
- 14 CONTRARY, THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF COLORADO APPLY TO EVERY
- 15 TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT EXECUTED OR RENEWED, OR UNDER WHICH
- 16 SERVICES ARE PERFORMED, WITHIN THE STATE OF COLORADO.

1 **SECTION 3. Effective date - applicability.** This act takes effect
2 on passage and applies to contracts executed or renewed on or after the
3 effective date of this act.

4 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
5 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
6 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".
