Summary of Legislation

Under current law, members of the planning commission in a Colorado city or town must serve without compensation. The bill authorizes, but does not require, the governing body of a city or town to pass an ordinance providing for the compensation of members of its planning commission.

Local Government Impact

The bill conditionally increases municipal expenditures. For those cities and towns that adopt an ordinance to compensate the planning commission, costs will increase based on the level of compensation in that ordinance.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 6, 2014, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 7, 2014, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
