Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB15-1273 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 14, after line 18 insert:

2 **"SECTION 9. Appropriation - legislative intent.** (1) For the
3 2015-16 state fiscal year, \$73,457 is appropriated to the department of
4 public safety for use by the division of criminal justice. This
5 appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that
6 the division will require an additional 1.0 FTE. To implement this act, the
7 division may use this appropriation for DCJ administrative services.

8 (2) The appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section
9 derives from savings generated from the implementation of the provisions
10 of Senate Bill 15-124, enacted in 2015.

11 **SECTION 10. Effective date.** (1) Except as specified in
12 subsection (2) of this section, this act takes effect upon passage.

13 (2) Section 5 of this act takes effect only if:

14 (a) The net reduction in the appropriations from the general fund
15 made in Senate Bill 15-124 is equal to or greater than the amount of the
16 general fund appropriation made in subsection 1 of section 9 of this act;

17 (b) Senate Bill 15-124 is enacted and becomes law; and

18 (c) The staff director of the joint budget committee files written
19 notice with the revisor of statutes no later than July 1, 2015, that the
20 requirement set forth in paragraph (a) of this subsection (2) has been
21 met.".

22 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

1 Page 1, line 104, strike "ACT." and substitute "ACT AND MAKING AN
2 APPROPRIATION."
