**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. J.001 (attached) provides the appropriation clause necessary for the purchase of personal services, temporary staff, expert consultants, and operating expenses by the Division of Professions and Occupations. The appropriations clause also authorizes the purchase legal services from the Department of Law by the Division of Professions and Occupations in the Department of Regulatory Agencies.

**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$58,587 to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2015-16 from the Division of Professions and Occupations Cash Fund. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.5 FTE. This

provision also appropriates a total of \$14,177 reappropriated funds to the Department of Law to provide legal services to the Department of Regulatory Agencies.
