After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB15-1206 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Finance with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, lines 5 and 6, strike "**recycling or**
2 **reprocessing of waste products**" and substitute "**waste reduction or**
3 **recycling equipment**".
- 4 Page 3, line 8, strike "ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF RECYCLING OR" and
5 substitute "THAT OPERATES A RECYCLING FACILITY OR A COMPOSTING
6 FACILITY REGISTERED WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
7 ENVIRONMENT".
- 8 Page 3, line 9, strike "REPROCESSING WASTE PRODUCTS".
- 9 Page 3, strike lines 12 through 14 and substitute "OR SALE OF ANY WASTE
10 REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT."
- 11 Page 3, line 25, strike "MACHINERY OR" and substitute "WASTE
12 REDUCTION OR RECYCLING".
- 13 Page 4, strike lines 8 through 27 and substitute:
14 (a) "HOME SCRAP" MEANS MATERIALS OR BY-PRODUCTS
15 GENERATED FROM AND COMMONLY REUSED WITHIN AN ORIGINAL
16 MANUFACTURING PROCESS;
17 (b) "MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE AS DEFINED IN SECTION
18 42-1-102 (58), C.R.S.;
19 (c) "POSTCONSUMER WASTE" MEANS PRODUCTS OR OTHER
20 MATERIALS GENERATED BY A BUSINESS, GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, OR

1 CONSUMER THAT HAVE SERVED THEIR INTENDED END USE AND HAVE BEEN
2 RECOVERED FROM OR OTHERWISE DIVERTED FROM THE SOLID WASTE
3 STREAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECYCLING;

4 (d) "PRECONSUMER MATERIAL" MEANS MATERIAL GENERATED
5 DURING ANY STEP IN THE PRODUCTION OF A PRODUCT AND RECOVERED OR
6 OTHERWISE DIVERTED FROM THE SOLID WASTE STREAM FOR THE PURPOSE
7 OF RECYCLING BUT DOES NOT INCLUDE HOME SCRAP;

8 (e) "RECOVERED MATERIALS" MEANS THOSE MATERIALS THAT
9 HAVE BEEN SEPARATED, DIVERTED, OR REMOVED FROM THE WASTE
10 STREAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECYCLING AND INCLUDES PRECONSUMER
11 MATERIAL AND POSTCONSUMER WASTE BUT NOT HOME SCRAP;

12 (f) "RECYCLING" MEANS THE SYSTEMATIC COLLECTING, SORTING,
13 DECONTAMINATING, AND RETURNING OF WASTE MATERIALS TO
14 COMMERCE AS COMMODITIES FOR USE OR EXCHANGE;

15 (g) "SOLID WASTE" MEANS ALL PUTRESCIBLE AND
16 NONPUTRESCIBLE WASTES IN SOLID OR SEMISOLID FORM, INCLUDING, BUT
17 NOT LIMITED TO, YARD OR FOOD WASTE, WASTE GLASS, WASTE METALS,
18 WASTE PLASTICS, WASTEPAPERS, WASTE PAPERBOARD, AND ALL OTHER
19 SOLID OR SEMISOLID WASTES RESULTING FROM INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL,
20 AGRICULTURAL, COMMUNITY, AND RESIDENTIAL ACTIVITIES; AND

21 (h) (I) "WASTE REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT" MEANS
22 NEW OR USED MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT WHICH IS OPERATED OR USED
23 EXCLUSIVELY IN THE STATE TO COLLECT, SEPARATE, PROCESS, MODIFY,
24 CONVERT, OR TREAT SOLID WASTE SO THAT THE RESULTING PRODUCT MAY
25 BE USED AS A RAW MATERIAL OR FOR PRODUCTIVE USE OR TO
26 MANUFACTURE PRODUCTS CONTAINING RECOVERED MATERIALS. "WASTE
27 REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT" INCLUDES DEVICES WHICH ARE
28 DIRECTLY CONNECTED WITH OR ARE AN INTEGRAL AND NECESSARY PART
29 OF SUCH MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT AND ARE NECESSARY FOR SUCH
30 COLLECTION, SEPARATION, PROCESSING, MODIFICATION, CONVERSION,
31 TREATMENT, OR MANUFACTURING.

32 (II) "WASTE REDUCTION OR RECYCLING EQUIPMENT" DOES NOT
33 INCLUDE MOTOR VEHICLES."

34 Page 5, strike lines 1 through 12.
