The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides a total of \$32,369 reappropriated funds from the Local Government Mineral Impact Fund to the Department of Local Affairs for FY 2015-16. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.5 FTE to implement the act.
