After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB15-1003 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 5 through 23 and substitute:
- 2 "(3.5) (b) (I) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a) of this
3 subsection (3.5), for the state fiscal ~~year~~ YEARS commencing July 1, 2014,
4 AND JULY 1, 2015, all of the grants awarded must be for noninfrastructure
5 programs.
- 6 (II) This paragraph (b) is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2015~~ JULY 1,
7 2018.
- 8 (5) (a) For the fiscal ~~year~~ YEARS commencing July 1, 2014, AND
9 JULY 1, 2015, if the state receives federal moneys for the safe routes to
10 school program, the state general fund appropriation for the program is
11 reduced by the amount of the federal moneys received.
- 12 (b) This subsection (5) is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2015~~ JULY 1,
13 2018.
- 14 **SECTION 2. Appropriation.** For the 2015-16 state fiscal year,
15 \$750,000 is appropriated to the department of transportation. This
16 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the
17 department may use this appropriation to make grants under the safe
18 routes to school program. Any moneys appropriated in this section not
19 expended prior to July 1, 2016, are further appropriated to the department
20 for the 2016-17 and 2017-18 state fiscal years for the same purpose."
- 21 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

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
