**REGISTRATION FEE:** \$40.00 per product.

## SECONDARY AND MICRONUTRIENTS:

When claims for micronutrients are made, the minimum percentages that will be accepted are as follows:

Calcium (Ca)	1.00%	Copper (Cu)	0.05%
Magnesium (Mg)	0.50%	Iron (Fe)	0.10%
Sulfur (S)	1.00%	Manganese (Mn)	0.05%
Boron (B)	0.02%	Molybdenum (Mo)	0.0005%
Chlorine (C)	0.10%	Sodium (Na)	0.10%
Cobalt (Co)	0.0005%	Zinc (Zn)	0.05%

## INSPECTION FEES:

- Registrants, except those who package fertilizers, soil conditioners and/or plant amendments in containers of 10 pounds or less, must pay for all commercial fertilizers distributed in the State of Colorado an inspection fee of \$.60/ton.
- Registrants of soil conditioners and/or plant amendments must pay an inspection fee of \$.10/ton.
- Registrants of specialty fertilizers packaged in containers of 10 pounds or less must pay an inspection fee of \$.075 per 100 pounds (\$.00075/pound).

Each registrant must file an annual tonnage affidavit (July 1 – June 30) within 45 days after each July 1 showing the tonnage of fertilizers, soil conditioners and/or plant amendments sold or distributed in the State of Colorado during the preceding 12-month period.

Each person, firm or corporation registering fertilizers, soil conditioners and/or plant amendments in the State of Colorado must keep adequate records showing the tonnage of all registered products shipped to, sold, offered for sale or distributed in the State of Colorado. The Commissioner and his duly authorized representatives shall have authority to examine such records to verify the statement of tonnage.
