Public School Capital Construction Assistance Board

On Thursday, May 22nd, Governor Bill Ritter signed House Bill 1335, the Building Excellent Schools Today Act, into law. This Act establishes the Public School Capital Construction Assistance Board, whose function according to statute is:

“to protect the health and safety of students, teachers, and other persons using public school facilities and maximize student achievement by ensuring that the condition and capacity of public school facilities are sufficient to provide a safe and uncrowded environment that is conducive to students’ learning.”

The Board consists of nine appointed members, of which the Governor appoints three members. The Governor will make appointments in the following categories:

- One member who is an architect whose professional practice includes the design and rehabilitation of public school facilities at the time of appointment or who has recent experience rehabilitating existing public school facilities and designing new public school facilities;
- One member who is an engineer whose professional practice at the time of appointment includes public school facilities engineering or who has recent experience in public school facilities engineering; and
- One member who is a construction manager who at the time of appointment manages public school facilities construction projects or who has recent experience managing such projects.

The GOVERNOR’S OFFICE OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS is now accepting applications for this board. **The application deadline for this board is FRIDAY, JUNE 6, 2008.**
