



FY 2008-09 PRIMARY CARE FUND AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT

September 2, 2008

The Department of Health Care Policy and Financing is pleased to announce the award decisions for FY 2008-09 under the Primary Care Fund. Award payments use provider's patient data from the previous calendar year. These payments are based on the percentage of medically indigent patients served by an individual provider in proportion to the total number of medically indigent patients served by all health care providers who qualify for moneys from this fund

The total funds available for FY 2008-09 are anticipated to be \$31,294,657. Each organization's payment is only an estimate since final award amounts are not known at this time because payments will be based on actual tax collections throughout the State fiscal year. The award percentages and estimated payments by provider are as follows:
