EXECUTIVE ORDER

Amending Executive Order D 006 08 Declaring a Disaster Emergency Due to the Contamination of the Public Water Supply in Alamosa County

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado and, in particular, pursuant to relevant portions of the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act of 1992, C.R.S. § 24-32-2100, *et seq.*, I, Bill Ritter, Jr., Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order amending Executive Order D 006 08, declaring a state of disaster emergency due to the contamination of the public water supply in Alamosa County, Colorado.

Section II(C) of Executive Order D 006 08 is amended to read, as follows:

- C. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-32-2104(6) and § 28-3-104, as commander-in-chief of military forces, I hereby employ and call to active duty certain elements of the Colorado National Guard as may be necessary to respond to this disaster, and delegate command authority to the Adjutant General of the Colorado Department of Military. I order the Adjutant General of the Colorado Department of Military and Veterans Affairs and the Director of the Colorado Division of Emergency Management to coordinate activities between their respective department and division as necessary to respond to this disaster emergency and execute the directives contained in this Executive Order.

In all other respects, Executive Order D 006 08 remains in full force and effect as originally promulgated.
