

Requirements and Forms for Commercial, Limited Commercial, or Public Applicator Licensing

Commercial Applicator (individual forms): An applicant for a commercial applicator's license must:

Employ, or have available by agreement, at least one qualified supervisor who is licensed in the category or subcategory of application being performed.

Download and complete the Notification of Qualified Supervisor or Certified Operators Form.

Provide proof of required insurance (minimum four hundred thousand dollar policy) on forms provided by the Commissioner. This form must be filled out and signed by the issuing insurance agent and returned with your application.

Download and complete the Commercial Applicator Certificate of Evidence of Liability Insurance.

Submit a Certificate of Good Standing from the Secretary of State if applicant is a corporation, a limited liability partnership, or a limited liability company. [Call (303) 894-2200 to obtain this document.]

If an aerial applicator, provide a copy of certification issued by the FAA under 14 CFR, Part 137.

Submit the \$350.00 license fee with the application.

Download and complete the Application for Commercial Pesticide Applicator's License.

Limited Commercial and Public Applicator (individual forms): An applicant for registration as a limited commercial or public applicator must:

Employ, or have available by agreement, at least one qualified supervisor who is licensed in the category or subcategory of application being performed.

Download and complete the Notification of Qualified Supervisors or Certified Operators Form.

Submit a Certificate of Good Standing from the Secretary of State if applicant is a corporation, limited liability partnership, or a limited liability company. [Call (303) 894-2251 to obtain this document]

Submit the \$50.00 registration fee with the application.

Download and complete the Application for Limited Commercial/Public Registration.

Complete Packet of Requirements and Forms for Commercial, Limited Commercial, or Public Applicator Licensing.

If any part of the application is missing your application will be returned to you.

Download and complete the Commercial Applicator Licensure Packet.

Download and complete the Limited Commercial/Public Registration Packet.
