Centennial Care Choices Program Panel

Senate Bill 217 authorizes the creation of the Centennial Care Choices Program to reduce the state's uninsured population and improve access to affordable healthcare. It calls for the appointment of a panel of expert advisors who shall prepare a request for information to be issued to health insurance carriers and other interested parties, including the State of Colorado, regarding the development of the Centennial Care Choices Program.

The panel of expert advisors is appointed by the Governor and shall include persons with expertise in the following areas:

- Actuarial sciences
- Designing health benefit plans
- Implementation and management of health benefit plans
- Disability issues
- Long term care
- Consumers
- Persons representing health care providers
