ICS Fiscal Year 2009 Fee Schedule Approved



On May 13, 2008, the Colorado Agricultural Commission and Department of Agriculture's Commissioner Stulp approved the Division of Inspection and Consumer Services (ICS) Fiscal Year (FY) 2009 Fee Schedule. This fee schedule will be effective on July 1, 2008.

The following are the fees that will change:

Increases:

- Farm Products Dealer License Fee - (\$250 to \$350)
- Farm Products Agent License Fee - (\$20 to \$25)
- Farm Products Small Volume Dealer License Fee - (\$25 to \$50)
- Feed Company Registration Fee - (\$25 to \$50)
- Feed Small Package Fee – Per Product - (\$15 to \$25)
- Feed Tonnage Minimum Late Fee - (\$40 to \$50)
- MS Large Scale Special Test Fee – Per Hour - (\$50 to \$100)

Decreases:

- Anhydrous Ammonia Bulk Site Registration Fee - (\$100 to \$75)
- Egg Class V Retail License Fee - (\$100 to \$75)
- Egg Retail Truck License - (\$5 to \$0)
- Fertilizer Product Registration Fee – Per Product - (\$50 to \$40)
- Several MS Scale Licenses:
 - 76 – 450# - (\$45 to \$40)
 - 451 – 2,000# - (\$75 to \$60)
 - 10,000 – 30,000# - (\$100 to \$90)
 - 30,001 – 80,000# - (\$150 to \$105)
 - 80,001+# - (\$200 to \$120)

All other program fees will remain at the current, FY 08 levels.
