REPORTABLE DISEASES IN COLORADO

The following diseases shall be reported to the Colorado Area Office of the USDA (303) 231-5385 or to the Colorado State Veterinarian's Office (303) 239-4161:

1. Anaplasmosis (Clinical Disease Only)
2. Anthrax
3. Avian Influenza (Both high or low pathogenic)
4. Brucellosis (Bovine, Porcine, Ovine, or Canine)
5. Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE)
6. Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD)
7. Contagious Equine Metritis (CEM)
8. Equine Encephalomyelitis (Also reportable to the Colorado Department of Public Health)
9. Equine Infectious Anemia (Positive Coggins/ELISA)
10. Equine Viral Arteritis
11. Equine Viral Rhinopneumonitis EHV #1 (Neurologic form only)
12. Exotic Newcastle Disease
13. Malignant Catarrhal Fever
14. Paratuberculosis (Johne's Disease)
15. Piroplasmiasis
16. Plague
17. Psittacosis
18. Pseudorabies
19. Rabies
20. Salmonella (pullorum or enteritidis)
21. Scabies (Cattle or Sheep)
22. Scrapie
23. Trichomoniasis
24. Tuberculosis
25. Tularemia
26. Vesicular Stomatitis, All Species
27. Vesicular Diseases of all livestock species
28. West Nile Virus

ANY DISEASE THAT IS SUSPECTED OF BEING FROM THE ABOVE LISTED DISEASES OR A FOREIGN ANIMAL DISEASE OR ANY INFECTIOUS DISEASE OR PARASITE OF LIVESTOCK WHICH WAS NOT PREVIOUSLY KNOWN TO EXIST IN COLORADO, I.E. ANY DISEASE OF UNUSUAL MORBIDITY OR MORTALITY THAT DOES NOT FIT THE NORMALLY EXPECTED CLINICAL PICTURE.
