Definitions of Unrestricted and Capacity Controlled Fares:

Unrestricted Fare: A full coach contract airfare is understood as a fare with no capacity controls that is fully refundable, requires no advance purchase, no overnight stay requirements, no flight specific limits and must have last seat availability.

Capacity Controlled Fare: A full coach contract airfare is understood as a fare with **capacity controls** that is fully refundable, requires no advance purchase, no overnight stay requirements, no flight specific limits.

Flight Standard--Abbreviations and Definitions:

N/S-Non-Stop service: Non-Stop service shall involve no stops en route between listed origin and destination.

D/C-Direct/Connecting service: Direct service shall involve no more than one stop en route between listed origin and destination. Connecting service between listed origin and destination shall involve no more than one (1) connecting flight segment in one direction with the connect time not to exceed one and a half (1 ½) hours for domestic flights. Connecting service for international flights shall involve no more than three (3) connecting flight segments in one direction within the contiguous 48 United States, providing the aggregate total of the connect times does not exceed four (4) hours.

STATE OF COLORADO CONTRACT FARE RULES AND RESTRICTIONS:

These official State of Colorado published government fares are effective from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2008 & represent one-way or each way & round-trip travel. These contract fares are available for official State of Colorado travel ONLY. These fares are published in computer reservation systems. Ticketing rules and purchase requirements will vary by airline. Individual rules are listed below. These city-pairs are defined by the origination and destination cities; connecting cities are of no consequence. Passenger Facility Charges (PFC's), segment fees and taxes are not included in the awarded fare and therefore may apply.

Use of Contract Carriers:

By the authority of the State Controller and the State's fiscal officers, the State of Colorado will require its travelers to obtain service first from the contractor for any city-pair under contract. The contract carrier is to be used except under one or more of the following conditions:

- a) Space or scheduled flights are not available to accomplish the purpose of the travel, and/or
- b) Use of available contract service would require the traveler to incur unnecessary travel expenses; and or
- c) If a non-contract carrier offers a lower fare available to the general public, including Internet fares, the use of which will result in a lower total trip cost to the State of Colorado; and/or
- d) If service is discontinued by awarded airline.

FARE RULES & TICKETING REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIC FOR EACH OF THE AWARDED AIRLINES:

GREAT LAKES AIRLINES

- ✦ All fares allow one way travel;
- ✦ All fares require NO advance purchase;
- ✦ All fares allow changes without penalty;
- ✦ All fares are fully refundable without penalty;
- ✦ All fares **DO** extend to political subdivisions.
- ✦ Travel allowed for **30** days (**July 30, 2008**) after end of contract date;
- ✦ Paper ticket fee: None at this time.
- ✦ Code Share: Frontier Airlines (F9); United Airlines (UA).

OTHER GOVERNMENT FARES:

Federal Fares: Use of any fares offered to the federal government or other state governments is not permitted; such use violates our price agreements and travel agency authorizations.

State Government Fares: State of Colorado contract fares always include our State abbreviation - CO - in the fare basis code; other state fares are similarly designated as in YCATX for Texas or YCAL for California. Use of fares issued by contract to other states is strictly prohibited and may subject the travel agency to **debit memos** from the airlines.

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
