## **Income Tax - Math Audit Letter**

What Is a Math Audit letter?

A math audit letter is a document sent from the Colorado Department of Revenue notifying a taxpayer of an adjustment the department made on the individual's income tax return. Math audit letters are a result of the return being filed incorrectly or, in many cases, without documentation necessary to support the income tax return being processed.

A summary indicating what adjustments were made is included in the letter for the taxpayer's information.
