

## UNCLASSIFIED FELONIES

### Elements of Offense

### C.R.S. Citation

1. ***Making profit on public money.*** The making of profit, directly or indirectly, out of state, county, city, town or school district money, or using the same for any purpose not authorized by law, by any public officer, is a felony. Colorado Constitution, Article X, Section 13
2. ***Colorado Antitrust Act of 1992.*** Violation of the provision of sections 6-4-104, 6-4-105, or 6-4-106 of the Colorado Antitrust Act of 1992 is a felony. 6-4-117 (2) Punishment is by a fine of not more than \$1,000,000.
3. ***Riots in detention facilities.*** It is a felony if a person engages in a riot in a detention facility, but does not employ a deadly weapon or destructive device. 18-8-211 (2) (b) The punishment is imprisonment in a correctional facility for not less than two years nor more than ten years.
4. ***Knowing endangerment.*** Any person who knowingly releases into the air any hazardous air pollutant and who knows at the time that such action places another person in imminent danger or death or serious bodily injury is guilty of a felony. 25-7-122.1 (3) (a) Punishment is a maximum fine of \$50,000 per each day of violation or up to four years imprisonment, or both.
5. ***Hazardous waste.*** Transporting hazardous waste to a facility having no permit; making any false statement or representation in any document filed or used for purposes of compliance with the law; and destroying, altering, or concealing any record required to be maintained pursuant to the statutes regarding storage, treatment, transportation, disposal, or handling of hazardous waste is a felony. 25-15-310 (3) The punishment is a fine of up to \$50,000 per day of violation or up to four years imprisonment, or both.
6. ***Officers not to reveal information.*** Revealing information which is stamped confidential pertaining to mine and metallurgical processes, ore bodies or deposits, or to the location, course, or character of underground workings is a felony. 34-21-106 (2) The punishment is a fine of \$1,000 to \$5,000 and removal from position.
7. ***False or fraudulent return, statement - penalty.*** Any person or corporation who willfully violates any of the provisions of section 39-26-120 regarding false or fraudulent sales tax returns commits a felony. 39-26-120 (2) The punishment is a fine of \$100,000 to \$500,000.
