

Important Notice to Colorado Gaming Industry

Delay of Expansion to Gambling Payment Intercept for Certified State Debt

The deployment of the latest expansion of the Gambling Payment Intercept (GPI) program has been delayed due to some technical issues. What this means for the gaming industry is that beginning January 1, 2012, when you process W-2Gs with the GPI registry, the registry will not search for certified state debt. However, it will continue to run the searches for outstanding child support payments and criminal restitution as is being done currently. In short, you will continue to comply with the GPI program as you have been doing with no changes. As soon as the Department arrives at a firm deployment date for the expansion that adds certified state debt to the registry, we will communicate that information to you.
