

IAPD Questions

Q1. Are there plans to share the IAPD budget and timeline publicly at some point?

Q2. How will the CBMS supplemental reporting process and work plan fit into the IAPD?

Q3. The CBMS supplemental is now the final part of the state budget for next fiscal year, including a reporting process and a separate work plan? Will everything be submitted together to CMS to get the 90/10 funding match?

Q4. How are the roles between OIT, CDHS, Counties, and HCPF defined?

Q5. Have all parties agreed on the definition of “minimum interoperability, and what is the final definition?

Q6. Can there be joint clarification on how the systems will work seamlessly as different members are enrolled into different systems? How is this achieved if a paper application is used?

Q7. It is critical to ensure we continue to figure out ways to compile data in one accessible place. It is difficult right now to test certain policies and program adjustments if we do not know what is working and what is not.

Q8. What process can stakeholders use to advocate for ideas mentioned in the ideas posted online or new ideas that were not included in the final IAPD?

Q9. Under section 3.3, Procurement and Solicitations, the IAPD mentions that Deloitte’s base contract ends at the end of State Fiscal Year 2013, but will be renewed for at least two years. Will there be meaningful accountability provisions in place to ensure the Deloitte is meeting its contractual agreements and standards and that there is a process if Deloitte is not meeting expectations?

HCPF Response

A1. Yes

A2. Most of the IAPD projects are also on the current work plan.

A3. All components of the IAPD that were submitted to CMS requested 90/10 funding.

A4. HCPF is the single state agency responsible for Medicaid and CHP+.

A5. *Minimum Interoperability* is the least amount of interaction between the state and COHBE to run a successful program.

A6. Any person will be able to go to COHBE or PEAK and based on data entered, be routed to the appropriate system for determination. Data from the paper application will be entered into the system, interfaces will run, and eligibility will be determined.

A8. Stakeholders need to continue to be involved in public meetings that are being held by HCPF.

A9. HCPF agrees. OIT is responsible for managing the Deloitte contract.
