




Vocational Rehabilitation's Economic Benefit to the State of Colorado




Increased Earnings and Hours Worked for all Consumers in Competitve Employment for SFY 2009



Consumer Occupations at Closure for SFY 2009




SFY 2009 - DVR Consumer Ethnicity as Compared to the Population of Colorado



NOTE: Consumers can report more than one ethnic background. Therefore the amounts shown can calculate greater than 100%.



Consumers Served by DVR in State Fiscal Year 2009




Consumers Successfully Rehabilitated in State Fiscal Year 2009




SFY 2009 - Average Increase in Annual Earnings - Post Rehabilitation Services



SFY 2009 - Annual Increase in Earnings of Consumers - Post Rehabilitation Services




Disabilities of Consumers Served and Successfully Rehabilitated in SFY 2009




General Fund / Federal Fund Summary SFY 2003 - SFY 2010
