The Colorado Bureau of Investigation's Forensic Services will host a 5-day Basic Crime Scene Class on the following dates and locations:

There will be no fee for this school; however, all meal and lodging expenses will be the responsibility of each attendee's agency. Successful demonstration of acquired skills throughout the week, as well as a passing score on a written exam, will be *required* to receive the course certificate. **Therefore, attendance for the entire week is mandatory.**

No students will be selected until after the application deadline. Please do not call to see if you have been chosen. **If you are selected, you will be notified no later than two weeks prior to the class start date.**

The course topics will consist of basic crime scene investigation and evidence recognition in the forensic disciplines of trace, drugs, bodily fluids, hairs and fibers, latent prints, footwear and tire impressions, evidence photography, gunshot residue, firearms, tool marks and digital evidence. The objective of the course is to provide students with sufficient knowledge to process "basic" crime scenes.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Crime scene personnel (sworn and non-sworn) employed by law enforcement agencies who are *actively involved* with crime scene investigations, including the collection and preservation of evidence. Focus of the class will be for those individuals with limited and/or no crime scene experience. The class is approved for 36 hours of Colorado P.O.S.T. credit. Please list your Colorado P.O.S.T. identification number on the application if you will be seeking P.O.S.T. credit for the class.

Attached is an application form. Each applicant must submit a separate application. The completed form must be mailed, e-mailed or faxed to the Denver CBI office no later than the application deadline listed for the corresponding class date.
