



## Community Overview

Nestled in the secluded Fraser Valley at the heart of Grand County, Granby Ranch is a carefully planned family community of nearly 5,000 acres. The sparkling Fraser River meanders through it. The majestic peaks of Rocky Mountain National Park and Indian Peaks Wilderness provide a stunning backdrop. The Ute and Arapahoe Indians were known to favor this area, and it's easy to see why, with its rolling grasslands, forested peaks, and trout-filled waters.

### **VISION**

From its architecture and activity programming, to the careful design of a base camp at the heart of the community -- every facet of Granby Ranch will bring the outdoors to life and inspire the whole family to experience, explore, and enjoy: campfires and mountain biking, hiking and fishing, skiing and snowshoeing, golfing, star-gazing and relaxing. ### **THE DEVELOPER**

### **LOCATION**

Granby Ranch is conveniently located a mere eighty miles northwest of Denver, Colorado, via Interstate 70 west to exit 232 (Hwy. 40). It is in the Town of Granby, 15 miles north of Winter Park, 12 miles from the town of Hot Sulphur Springs, less than 18 miles from Rocky Mountain National Park, and only 15 miles from Grand Lake (Colorado's largest natural body of water nestled at the western edge of Rocky Mountain National Park).

The Club is your all-access pass to Granby Ranch. When you live at Granby Ranch, Colorado's family-friendly mountain valley is right outside your back door. ## **GOLF**

Open since summer of 2001, the *Headwaters Golf Course* at Granby Ranch boasts one of the largest practice facilities in Colorado with a double-ended driving range. The course weaves gracefully along the Fraser River and has been skillfully designed to showcase breathtaking mountain views. Drives will soar at an elevation of 8,100 feet on this par 72, 7,290 yard course. The golf season ranges from May through mid October depending upon weather.

## **RIVER/FISHING**

Private access to the meandering Fraser River is every angler's dream. Granby Ranch contains over three miles of pristine trout fishing on the Fraser. This private water is divided into guided and non-guided sections. The Granby Ranch Outfitter is at your service with professional fly-fishing guides, equipment, and fly recommendations.

## **SKIING**

Spread over two mountains, *SolVista Basin* ski area appeals to all skier levels, with 35 downhill trails and several miles of snowshoe and Nordic ski trails. A separate learn-to-ski park offers lessons for all ages and the newly renovated Base Camp Lodge welcomes you at the end of an exciting day on the slopes. One of the most family-friendly ski areas in Colorado offering the highest levels of service and amenities, SolVista Basin features hassle-free access to the slopes, extensive children's programs, beginner friendly runs and lifts, and an easy-to-navigate trail network where all runs lead to the same base area location. Weather permitting, the season ranges from mid December through March.

Newly renovated in 2007, Base Camp Lodge offers everything to make a family ski experience ideal, including a new ski school space, an updated retail and rental area, a renovated dining hall and Granby Ranch's own Seven Trails Grille, a full service restaurant. The build out of the Master Plan for the Base Camp Village area is underway with Base Camp One, a luxury alpine condominium project adjacent to the Lodge, having recently been completed. The first phase of the Grange Hall has been completed and includes a fitness facility, game area and living room, which serves as a community gathering spot. Phase two has not commenced, but is anticipated to include a hot tub and pool facility.

## **BIKE PARK**

When the snow melts in spring, SolVista Basin is quickly transformed into one of North America's premier mountain biking destinations. In just a three year span, the *SolVista Bike Park* has become renowned for its world-class mountain biking opportunities and has hosted the USA Cycling National Championships in 2009 and 2010 and regularly hosts the Mountain States Cup for the regional qualifying competition. Riders have the option of accessing SolVista's purpose-built alpine biking trails via chairlift or discovering our vast cross-country trail network starting right outside our base lodge. Boasting trails for riders of all ability levels, the SolVista Bike Park is sure to get the endorphins kicking for everyone.

## **TRAIL SYSTEM**

Approximately 25km of hiking trails have been designed to offer easy access to this pristine Rocky Mountain sanctuary. The Winter Park to Granby trail passes through the property, links to the existing trail network and offers even more hiking, biking, and horseback riding opportunities. Neighborhoods are being designed to contain recreational open space adjacent to most lots. This space will enable the expansion of the trail system throughout Granby Ranch and will interconnect neighborhoods to create a true sense of community.
