Description

The Division of Housing includes the Homeless Prevention Team that is carrying forward the Governor's plan to end homelessness, [Pathways Home Colorado](#). The Division coordinates and administers federal programs to help the homeless, including the Emergency Solutions Grant, HEARTH, Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS, Shelter +Care, C-SHARP, VASH, and state funding received through the tax checkoffs called the Homeless Prevention Activities Program. It also houses the Office of Homeless Youth Services. The Division provides funds from these programs to non-profit organizations and local governments.
